1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Tony Baxter, Heather Coleman and Wendy Phillips.

2. Minutes from the Previous Meeting

The minutes from the previous meeting were agreed as a true and accurate record.

3. Matters Arising

i) ACC

Clare Wilson updated the group that they now have someone in house who can update the website and will put the minutes onto the website. The last four sets will be sent to Clare Wilson. CH

Concern arose that the minutes from this meeting needed to be approved before they go on to the website but the next meeting was not until June and the minutes would be out of date by then. It was agreed to send the minutes round to attendees and approve as soon as possible. CH

ii) QC4 Aircrafts

John McCabe noted that agreement had been reached with the application and a meeting with the planning department was organised for early next year. An update would be brought to the next meeting. JMc

iii) Tracking System

This was working well and will be reviewed in January.

iv) Noise Complaints

Claire Wilson informed the group that there had been around 70 complaints a month during July – September but during October only 39 were received, this was probably due to the decrease in flights during winter.

v) Bike loan scheme

6 people had taken up this scheme

An annual survey would be undertaken next year on cycling to work, new green resolutions would be looked at for launching in the new year.

The draft transport plan would be launched in the new year.

Bus service – there were 5 bus services an hour running to the airport and staff were still offered a 15% discount on bus passes.

4. Health Impact Assessment

It was raised that with the proposals for the QC4 flights this would be a variation to the 106 agreement and it was felt that this needed to be reviewed and would be an agenda item at the next meeting.

The group noted that it would be the airports 5th Anniversary in April 2010.

The questions asked regarding the masterplan would be published in April, this was felt to be positive and a news article had been published around this.

5. Employment Data

This item was deferred to the next meeting.

6. Port Health Service

June Chambers noted that the room and the Port Health Plan were now complete.
